

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

El Espacio 23 in partnership with Fundación Ama Amoedo Open call 2026-2027

El Espacio 23 in partnership with Fundación Ama Amoedo opens the call for artists and curators from Argentina. Two slots will be granted to participate in a five-week residency in El Espacio 23, located in Allapattah, Miami, USA: one for a curator-in-residence (July-August 2026) and one for an artist-in-residence (February-March 2027).

The residency is part of FAARA CONECTA, an initiative of Fundación Ama Amoedo for artists to participate in international residencies. The goal is to foster dialogue between artists, expand networks and stimulate artistic production in different contexts.

The five-weeks Residency include:

- Round-trip economy airfare to Miami
- Travel insurance
- Accommodation in Miami for the duration of the residency
- Access to workspace and facilities at El Espacio 23
- Curatorial and professional networking opportunities as part of the residency program
- Institutional support and guidance during the stay
- Professional fee of USD\$ 1,000
- An stipend of USD\$1,200 to cover personal and professional expenses
- Production funds of USD\$ 1,000

El Espacio 23 is a nonprofit contemporary art space founded by collector and philanthropist Jorge M. Pérez. Open to the public free of charge, it presents exhibitions, residencies, and special projects drawn from the Pérez Collection. Located in Miami's Allapattah neighborhood, the institution serves as a platform for artistic production, research, and cross-cultural dialogue. Its programming reflects the collection's strengths in African and African diasporic art, Latin American art and its diasporas, and a significant presence of artists from the United States alongside selected European contexts. International in scope, the collection informs a curatorial approach that foregrounds transnational exchange, intergenerational dialogue, and artistic practices shaped by migration and evolving cultural histories.

El Espacio 23 also maintains an artist and curator residency program with onsite housing and a shared workspace. The residency provides living accommodations, studio access, and a production budget for participants at different stages of their careers across a range of disciplines and backgrounds. Residents are selected by the curatorial team in dialogue with the exhibition program, the context of Miami, the Jorge M. Pérez Collection, and partner institutions. Through its exhibitions and programs, El Espacio 23 brings together artists from diverse geographic and social contexts, placing established figures in dialogue with emerging voices and highlighting practices that engage social histories, identity, memory, belonging, and the conditions shaping artistic production.

Conceived with the mission of creating a lasting impact on the Latin American contemporary art ecosystem, Fundación Ama Amoedo was established by Amalia Amoedo to channel her twenty year long independent philanthropic and patronage activities. Fundación Ama Amoedo operates through two non-profit civil organizations: one established in Uruguay in 2021, through which it develops programs, residencies, and initiatives with regional and international scope; and another established in Argentina in 2025, created to channel and strengthen support for artists, cultural spaces, publications, and art-related projects based in that country. Across its programming, the Foundation seeks to encourage connections within the arts in Latin America and its global extensions, aiming to foster the presence of artists from the region and to amplify their visibility on the international scene.

1. Requirements

- Argentine nationality (Living inside or outside the country).
- Individuals with an active professional practice and a demonstrated trajectory in the visual arts field.
- Fluency in English.
- Valid U.S. visa at the time of residency.

The following are not eligible to apply:

- Previous recipients of FAARA CONECTA.
- Immediate family members, employees or current collaborators of Fundación Ama Amoedo or El Espacio 23.

2. Responsibilities of Selected Participants

Selected residents agree to:

- Be present and actively engaged for the full duration of the residency.
- Respect the rules, facilities, and community guidelines of El Espacio 23.
- Submit a brief final report or reflection within a reasonable timeframe after the residency.
- Allow photographic and audiovisual documentation of their residency process for institutional, educational, and communication purposes.

3. Application form

Applications must be submitted through email address indicated in the call and must include all required materials:

- Application form (which includes personal information, artist or curatorial statement, motivation outlining interest and work proposal for the residency).
- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Portfolio (artists) or curatorial or research portfolio (curators)

To apply, complete the form available on our websites.

The subject of the email must indicate either:

“[CURATOR] El Espacio 23 | full name” or “[ARTIST] El Espacio 23 | full name”

Applications may be submitted in spanish or english. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

4. Dates

The call is open from Friday, March 20 to Monday, April 26, 2026. The selected artist and curator will be announced in May.

5. Intellectual Property and Use of Materials

Applicants retain full copyright of their work.

By applying, applicants grant Fundación Ama Amoedo and El Espacio 23 the right to use submitted materials and documentation produced during the residency (including images, texts, and audiovisual records) for non-commercial communication, educational, and archival purposes, always with proper credit.

6. Cancellations and Changes

Fundación Ama Amoedo and El Espacio 23 reserve the right to adjust residency dates, format, or conditions due to circumstances beyond their control (including but not limited to force majeure events, travel restrictions, or institutional reasons). If a selected participant is unable to attend, the organizers may offer the residency to an alternate candidate.

7. Acceptance of Terms

By submitting an application, applicants confirm that they have read, understood, and fully accepted these Terms and Conditions.
